HELPFUL HINTS:

- **Read rules carefully, especially in regards to theme & spelling**
- **Posters should be clearly read from a distance (use large enough font)**
- **Words should be CLEAR & LEGIBLE, not tiny**
- **Theme or title (or shortened/modified version) should appear on poster**
- **If using a website on poster, NO other website addresses should appear on poster except www.labmf.org**
- **NO QUOTES, copyrighted figures/names/objects. NO Graphics. Only freehand artwork.**
- **NO SPELLING ERRORS, or poster will be disqualified**
- **Bold colors best, pale colors hard to see; no reflective markers, ink**
- **Carefully read & follow all the Rules on the reverse side of this letter**

**2018 TEEN DATING VIOLENCE AWARENESS & PREVENTION POSTER CONTEST RULES
FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

THEME: “How to Help a Friend” focuses on *ways to help a friend who is in an abusive relationship*. Theme or title (or shortened/modified version) should appear on poster. Use www.labmf.org as a resource.

ELIGIBILITY: Contest is open to all high school students in the State of Rhode Island.

PRIZES: **First Place: \$1000.00 Second Place: \$500.00 Third Place: \$200.00**

JUDGING CRITERIA: Judging will be based on originality, creativity, and development and reflection of the theme. As a resource, visit www.labmf.org and other websites from our LINKS page.

RULES:

Submitted artwork should be on heavy construction paper, matte finish, size 11 X 17, leaving a one inch plain border at the bottom (artwork should then be 11 X 16). Use **vertical orientation**. Do not put your name on the front of poster.

1. **Original, freehand artwork** in any medium, color or black and white. Keep in mind pencils appear light. **Computer graphics, computer-generated artwork and copyrighted figures/names/objects NOT accepted. Nothing glued, stapled or attached to artwork. No cut & paste.**
2. **NO SPELLING ERRORS; clear, legible words.**
3. Only one entry per student, and each entry must be the work of only one student.
4. All entries become the property of the Lindsay Ann Burke Memorial Fund and cannot be returned. We reserve the right to use the posters for the purpose of dating violence education and promotion. A picture of the winning student may appear in the media and/or our newsletter/website/dvd/etc. as well.
5. Posters may not be folded or rolled. They must be mailed flat and protected by cardboard. Packages must be labeled “Do Not Bend” on both sides. Mail posters to: **Lindsay Ann Burke Memorial Fund, PO Box 1748, North Kingstown, RI 02852**
6. **All entries must be received by April 6, 2018.** Winners will be notified in April. Presentation of prizes to be made at a School Committee Meeting or equivalent, if possible.

HELPFUL HINTS: Posters must be clearly read from a distance (use large enough font). If using a website address on the poster, **NO** other website addresses should appear on poster except labmf.org. **Bold colors look better than pale, washed-out colors. NO quotes on posters. Visit www.labmf.org for examples of previous winning posters.**

REGISTRATION FORM: Complete the following, printing clearly. Attach this section to the back of your poster with invisible tape. Parent signature gives permission to LABMF to use student’s picture in newspaper/LABMF newsletter and permission to use poster for any educational purpose.
