

# 2021-22 CLOTHESLINE PROJECT



## LABMF to fund the Clothesline Project in Rhode Island high schools

**PURPOSE**: to raise awareness of teen dating violence during February, National Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Month

**ELIGIBILITY**: Any RI high school faculty member(s) working with a student group or class may apply. Faculty member(s) & students must work independently of any other DV agency or outside partner. This project may **not** be part of a school fundraiser for any other community agency (except LABMF, if you choose).

LABMF will provide up to \$200.00 per school for the cost of t-shirts or heavy weight paper, fabric paint and/or fabric markers, clothesline and clothespins if desired. Clothesline Project t-shirts must be displayed in school in a highly visible area(s) during February.

**WHAT IS A CLOTHESLINE PROJECT?** Students design and paint t-shirts with factual or artistic info about dating violence. T-shirts are usually displayed on a clothesline to make a powerful statement to the entire school community. Other suggested activities to raise awareness in conjunction with the Clothesline Project include daily or weekly schoolwide PA announcements of tdv facts, student-created brochures, the wearing of "Clothesline" t-shirts in school by students on a specific day(s) during the month, or any other activity that the students and faculty member deem appropriate.
